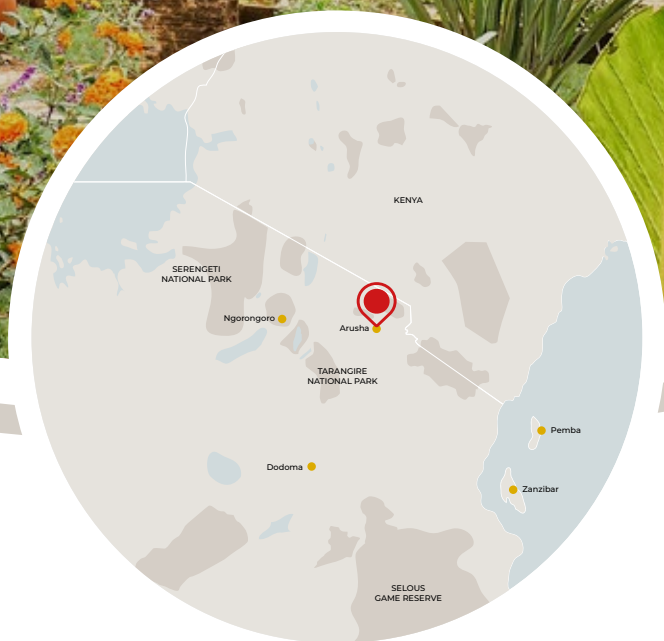
Relaxing in African style

Africa Safari Arusha is an intimate lodge set in the village of Sakina, just outside Arusha's city centre. The property accommodation consists of 9 Standard rooms and 8 Luxury rooms, surrounded by lush green gardens, a swimming pool with sun loungers and an open-air restaurant with a fireplace for the colder evenings. The unique tree bar is a great spot to enjoy a pre or post-dinner drink.

Mount Meru is perfectly positioned as the lodge's backdrop while views from the balconies span beyond the bright city lights of Arusha to the mountainous countryside. As you travel to Africa Safari Arusha on an unpaved road through the Ngateu Hills, there is no mistaking the very real sense of calm and culture.

The Standard rooms are in a building with 4 rooms per floor. The rooms are located along an open corridor that runs the length of the building. The Luxury rooms are in 4 stand-alone circular buildings with two floors; each floor is a room. The Standard Family room is an open-plan room, furnished with a double bed and two sets of bunk beds, accommodating up to six guests in a spacious environment.

Africa Safari Arusha promotes a harmonious combination of comfort and culture for an all-encompassing yet authentic experience in Arusha.

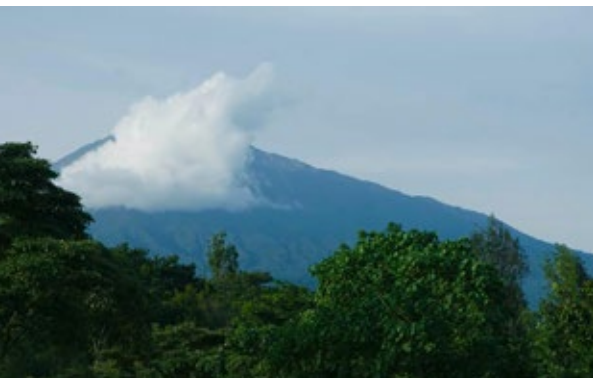

ARUSHA, THE SAFARI CAPITAL OF TANZANIA

Arusha is a charming town in northern Tanzania with plenty to do. It is the third-largest city in Tanzania, known as 'Tanzania's safari capital' and lies at the foot of Mount Meru. The city is also known as the 'Geneva of Africa', ever since Bill Clinton compared Arusha to the city in Switzerland.

The city came into being when the area became part of German East Africa in 1900. Today it is a vibrant city with an interesting mix of markets, chaotic traffic, old colonial buildings and modern shopping malls.

It is the perfect base to visit some of Africa's most famous landscapes and natural attractions, including the Serengeti, the Rift Valley, Ngorongoro Crater, Lake Manyara, Tarangire, Lake Natron, and, of course, Arusha National Park.

Arusha is known for being the tourism capital of Tanzania, and it is the perfect starting point for discovering the National Parks and Game Reserves of the Northern Circuit.



National Parks and Game Reserves of the Northern Circuit in Tanzania:



Serengeti National Park

Endless plains and stunning savannah sprawl over 14,763 sq km, bustling with wildlife, notably the iconic Wildebeest migration, a majestic spectacle of nature's vitality and beauty.



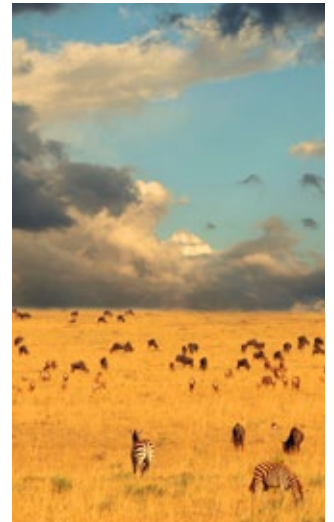
Serengeti North & Mara River

Encounter the famed wildebeest crossing at the Mara River, which carves through the plains, offering challenging twists and turns, varying in intensity and danger, to the migrating herds on their epic journey.



Serengeti Central/ Seronera Area

The 'Big Cat Capital', Seronera, hosts plentiful wildlife, including lions, leopards, and cheetahs. The area is studded with rocky granite outcrops, or kopjes, which are fabulous lookout points for predators.



Kusini Area in the Serengeti

A tranquil safari experience awaits in the south Serengeti, boasting an abundance of predators and resident wildlife. Kusini offers picturesque landscapes and diverse ecosystems, providing intimate wildlife encounters away from the crowds.



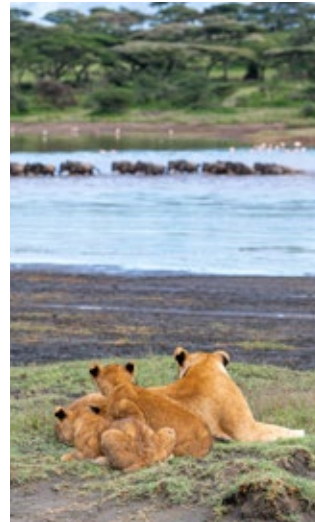
Ikona Wildlife Management Area (WMA)

A vital part of the Serengeti ecosystem, offering a pristine wilderness supporting diverse wildlife, including elephants and rare antelope species. Spectacular night game drives are offered in this well-kept secret area.



Ngorongoro Crater

Explore the world's largest intact volcanic caldera, home to the Big Five and abundant wildlife amidst stunning natural surroundings. Here you'll discover the true power and divinity of Mother Nature.



Ndutu Area

The Ndutu area, located in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and bordering the Serengeti, is rich in wildlife all year round. Wildlife numbers peak between December and April when the best viewing is the plains around Lake Ndutu. The area also caters for birdwatchers.



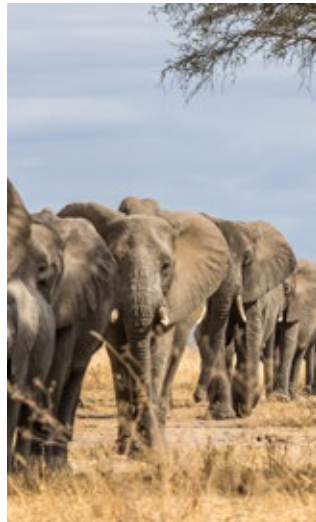
Lake Manyara National Park

An underestimated gem of safari parks. Encounter tree-climbing lions and over 400 bird species, including thousands of strolling flamingos, in this diverse park, featuring alkaline soda lakes and lush forests.



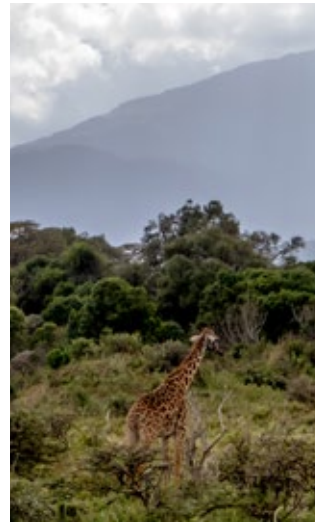
Lake Natron

An opportunity to experience the breathtaking sight of millions of flamingos at the alkaline lake, surrounded by remote, otherworldly landscapes and stunning views of Ol Doinyo Lengai volcano.



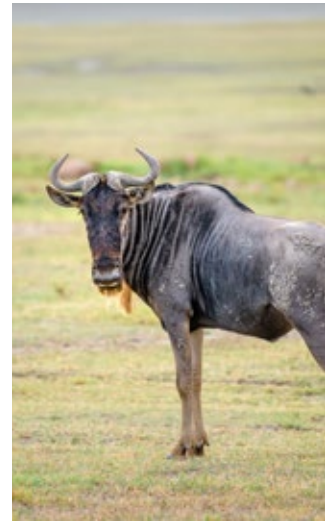
Tarangire National Park

Boasting the highest concentration of wildlife outside Serengeti and known as the home of elephants, Tarangire offers abundant wildlife viewing opportunities in a compact, easily accessible park.



Arusha National Park

Famed for the rare black and white Colobus monkey and diverse birdlife, this park consists of mountainous terrain, lush rainforests, and serene lakes, offering activities such as unique canoeing and walking safaris.



Pololeti Game Reserve:

Not only is this an important area for breeding wildebeest, and a corridor for the animals coming from the Serengeti, but because wildlife knows no boundaries, you will find a wide variety of animals here.

Activities

ARUSHA CITY TOUR

Take half a day to discover the beauty of Arusha Town, from the Clock Tower (the halfway point between Cairo in Egypt and Johannesburg in South Africa) to the Arusha Declaration Monument and Museum.



ARUSHA MAASAI MARKET

The overwhelming souvenir and craft market where you will quickly learn to bargain because the Tanzanians have mastered this art! Wall hangings, baskets, kitchenware, safari boots and hats, T-shirts, beaded necklaces, textiles and fabrics, soapstone carvings and wooden sculptures.



ARUSHA NATIONAL PARK

Additional activities during a game drive in Arusha NP can be organised, however only in combination with a full day visit to this National Park. A canoe trip on the small Momella Lake or a 2-2.5 hour cycling adventure can be organised on special request.



KIKULETWA HOT SPRINGS

In this remote area, locals also come to relax and take a dip. You can jump out of the trees or swing on a rope and dive into the crystal-clear water. Enjoy the beautiful scenery; it's like a small oasis where you can even get a free pedicure from the nibbling fish.



LAKE DULUTI NATURE WALK

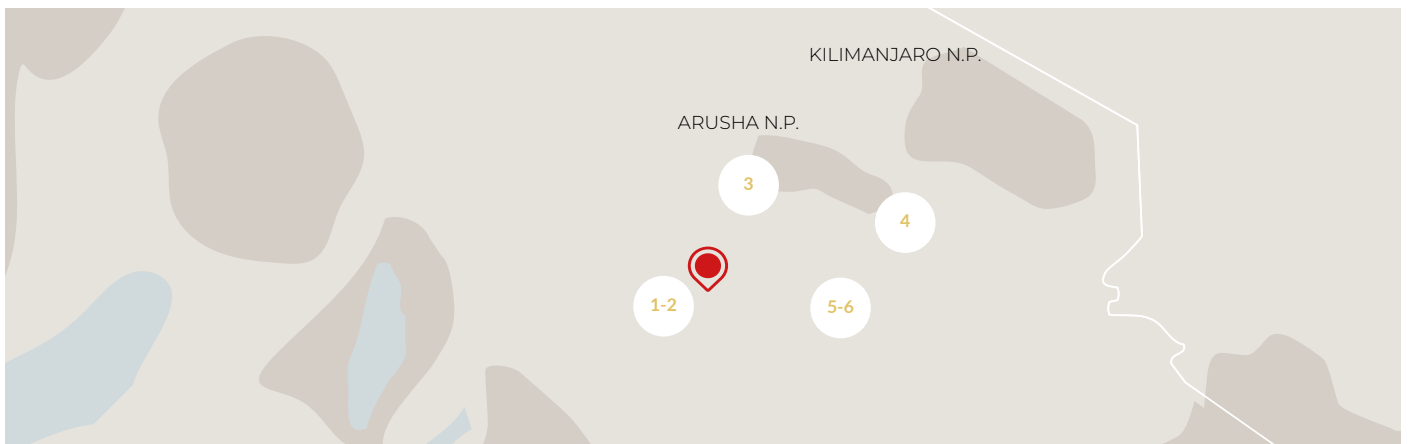
Lake Duluti is a volcanic crater lake situated in the Arusha region, specifically in the Meru District near the town of Tengeru. Take pleasure in a stroll beneath the canopy of Lake Duluti as your guide identifies the numerous beautiful bird types, totalling 130 species in the area, along with the diverse forest flora.



CANOEING LAKE DULUTI

Glide across the smooth surface of this small crater lake and observe the rarely seen birds: Giant Kingfisher, African Fish Eagle, Darters, and many more. Surrounded by forested crater walls, this 1.5-hour canoeing experience is truly special and peaceful.

A four-wheel drive safari jeep with a pop-up roof, including driver and fuel, is available for hire on request. Our driver guides are very knowledgeable and will ensure you have as much time as you need to ask questions, take pictures, and enjoy the incredible landscape.

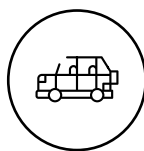

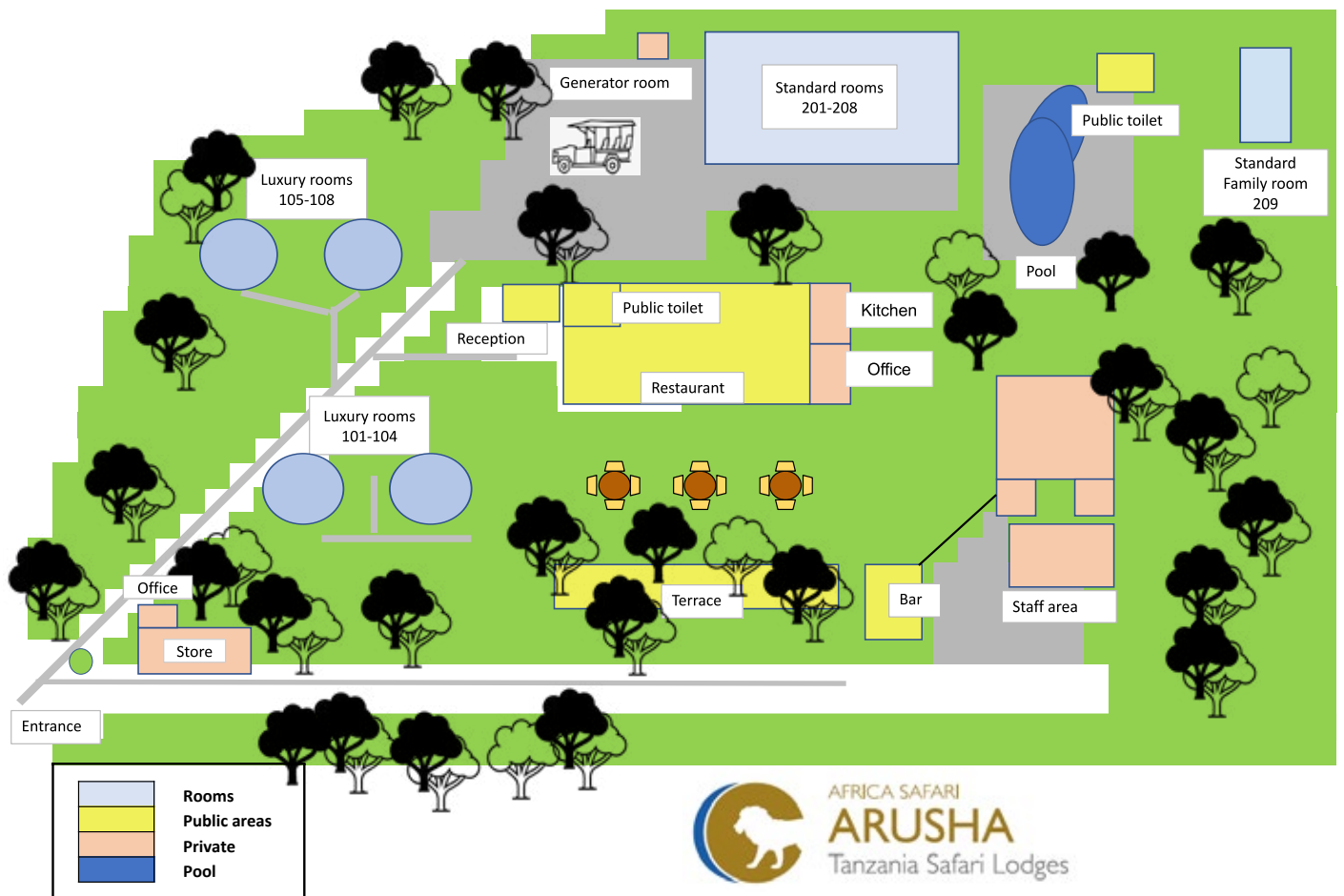

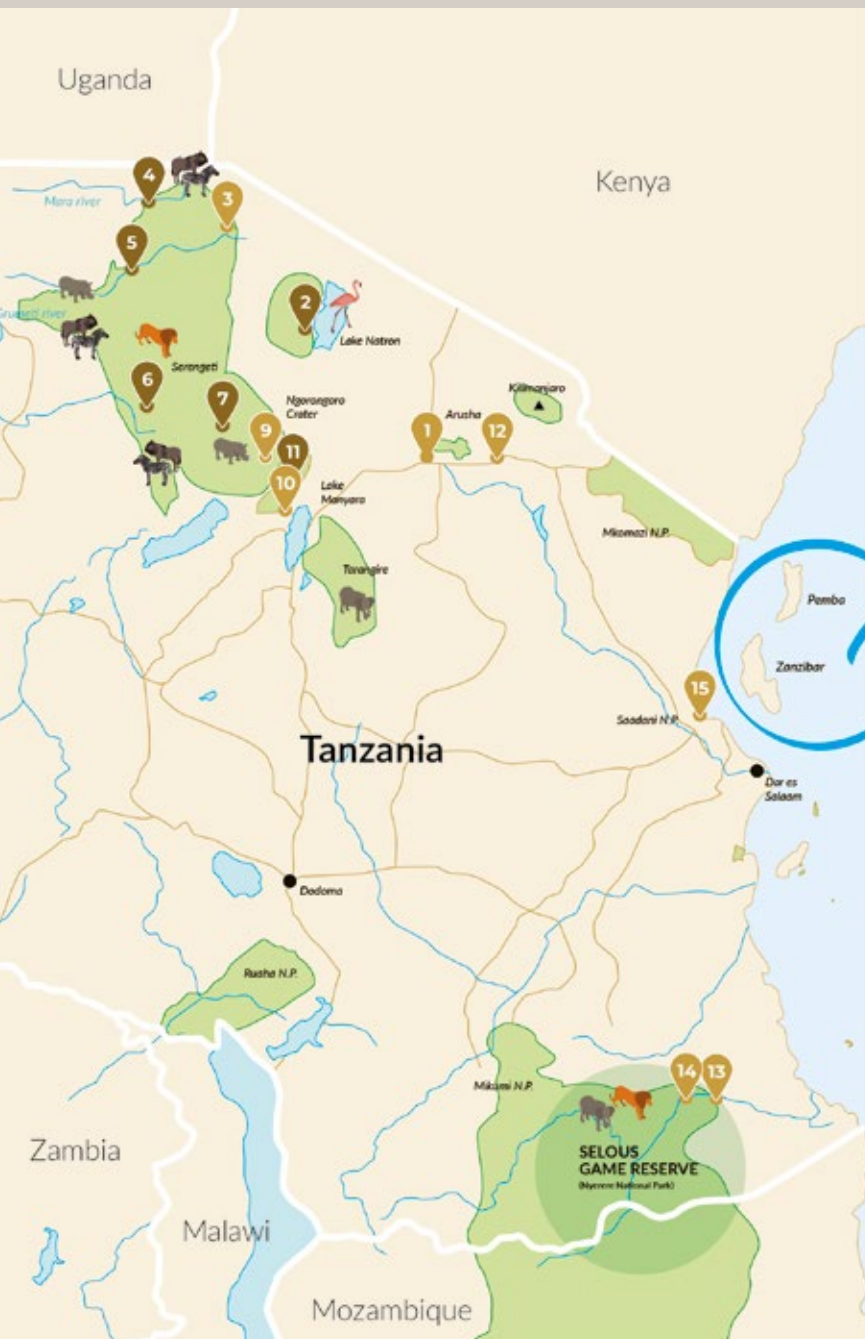
