

Africa Safari Rift Valley is located in the village of Mayoka, south of Lake Manyara, surrounded by the famous Great Rift Valley. Conveniently located between Tarangire and Lake Manyara, this is the perfect location for relaxation before or after visiting Tanzania's northern National Parks.

Safari Luxury Glamping accommodations feature a raised tiled deck and all the desired luxuries inside, including airconditioning and ensuite bathroom. This room category also features an outdoor shower, providing the unique opportunity to shower under the open sky surrounded by the sights and sounds of the wilderness. There are also 5 Safari Tents available, with shared toilet and shower facilities.

The swimming pool and restaurant are embedded in the surrounding landscape offering a beautiful view of the Rift Valley and Lake Manyara.


The southern entrance of Lake Manyara National Park, Iyambi Gate, is only a short distance away. This national park has a variety of wildlife including the famous tree-climbing lions and is a sanctuary for hippos, giraffes, impalas, and zebras, whilst the lake itself is a magnet for birdlife.

Tarangire National Park's Sangaiwe Gate is approximately 1,5 hours drive away. Tarangire is known for its high number of scenic baobab trees and is home to the largest population of elephants in Northern Tanzania

This special safari lodge owes its name to the famous Rift Valley, which is one of the Natural Wonders of the World.

Tourists can access Lake Manyara National Park through different access gates located in the northern and southern parts of the National Park. The northern gate is commonly used by tourists visiting the destination, but from Africa Safari Rift Valley the southern gate, lyambi Gate, is the gate to enter the National Park. To access Lake Manyara National Park visitors are required to pay entrance fees.








### Lake Manyara National Park

Lake Manyara National Park, an underrated gem among safari parks, offers great ecological diversity in a small area. The alkaline soda of the lake attracts impressive numbers of birds that thrive on the water. More than 400 species have been identified and one of the highlights is the thousands of flamingos. From the park's main entrance, the road winds through an area of groundwater forests.

On the grassy banks of the lake, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and the great buffalo can be seen grazing throughout the day. The park also offers excellent opportunities for hippo watching. The mahogany and acacia trees are inhabited by the famous tree-climbing lions; with a bit of luck you may see them lazing on tree branches.





## Tarangire National Park

Tarangire National Park is a fun and easy park to explore. The game is abundant and exposed because the park is more compact and the terrain is open. In the dry season, the Tarangire River is the only permanent source of water. Tarangire NP is 2850 square kilometres in size, making it the sixth largest park in Tanzania. It offers the highest concentration of wildlife after the Serengeti.

Tarangire is known for its Baobab trees and the large herds of elephants that can be seen from up close. Other animals that can be seen in Tarangire are: wildebeests, zebras, buffaloes, gazelles, warthogs, impalas, pythons, lions, leopards and almost 500 species of birds.

## Rift Valley

The Great Rift Valley is the world's most famous vallev and stretches from the Middle East to Mozambique. In Tanzania the Rift Valley created a unique environment that combines lakes, mountains, volcanos and has a very abundant wildlife. The environment of the Rift Valley is a great example of how many natural systems can be intertwined. and is therefore the perfect place to visit for nature lovers.

## Activities / Interesting places to visit


#### 150 CORNERS ROAD

Located on the slopes of Mount Magara you will find Tanzania's most windy road, which connects the 100 km between Mbulu and Karatu. Famous for its winding nature, with approximately 150 corners, the road was constructed by the Germans during colonial times and served as a pass through the region. Starting at an elevation of around 980 metres and reaching its peak at approximately 1150 metres, this road is well-known for its scenic beauty and stunning views of the African landscape and the terraced fields cultivated by the Iraqw tribe.



#### THE ROMAN CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF MBULU

The Apostolic Prefecture of Mbulu was founded in 1943 in the city of Mbulu and later, in 1953, it was elevated to the status of the Diocese of Mbulu. It is one of the largest cathedrals in the region and is a striking vision in the vast landscape with its distinctive design and

#### DEVELOPMENT:

The Lake Manyara Biosphere Reserve, where Africa Safari Rift Valley is located, has a human population of over 250 thousand people. The ethnic groups in this area are the Maasai, Iraqw and Barbaig, where the most important socio-economic activities are pastoralism and agriculture. Most of the immigrants in this area depend on tourism and approximately 80% of all tourists who come to Tanzania visit this reserve primarily for nature-based activities such as hiking, biking, day and night game drives, as well as photographic tourism. The tourism sector provides a wide range of advantages, including job creation, foreign exchange earnings, support for small and medium-sized local businesses, and the generation of funds used for various ecological initiatives within the Lake Manyara Biosphere Reserve.
