Relaxing in African style

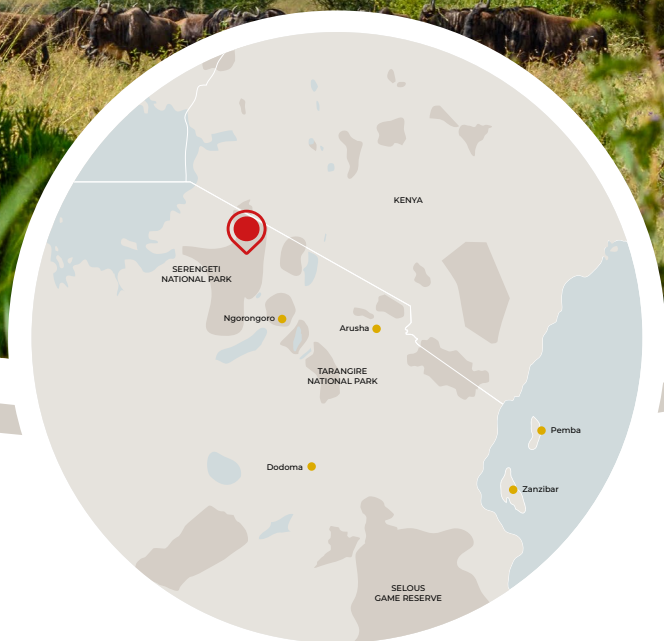
Located within the Serengeti Ecosystem, Africa Safari Serengeti Ikoma provides a comfortable safari experience. The camp is 300 metres from the National Park boundary and within the Game Controlled Area of the Tanzanian Wildlife Authority (TAWA).

Positioned between Serengeti Seronera, Grumeti and Ikorongo Game Reserves, the location is perfect for exploring the Serengeti and all that there is to do in one of the country's largest National Parks. Due to its proximity to the Grumeti River, Africa Safari Serengeti Ikoma has a backyard full of animals and the Great Migration is present several months of the year. Additionally, the Ikoma Game Controlled Area has proven to be a hidden treasure

for wildlife. The area is home to migrating animals from the Serengeti National Park and the Maasai Mara Game Reserve in Kenya.

The spacious property offers accommodations catering to all budgets and tastes, from pre-built safari tents to canvas Comfort Rooms. The Comfort Rooms also feature a permanent ensuite bathroom and stunning views across the plains of the Serengeti.

Together with a TAWA ranger, night game drives and bushwalks are also available in the area.

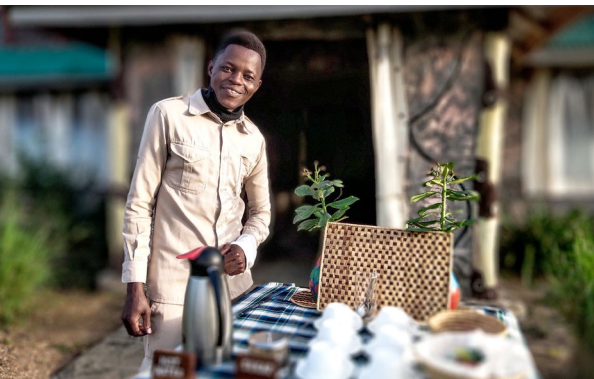




LOCATION
Located in Ikoma, north west Serengeti

Due to its central location, Africa Safari Serengeti Ikoma is suitable for a multi-night stay to explore the fascinating surroundings and discover the phenomenal variety of wildlife in the Serengeti National Park. Africa Safari Serengeti Ikoma can be reached from many directions. From Seronera via the Fort Ikoma gate, while the Tabora ´B´ gate gives easy access to the northern Serengeti. From Mwanza, take the Ndabaka gate or come via Bunda and avoid park fees.

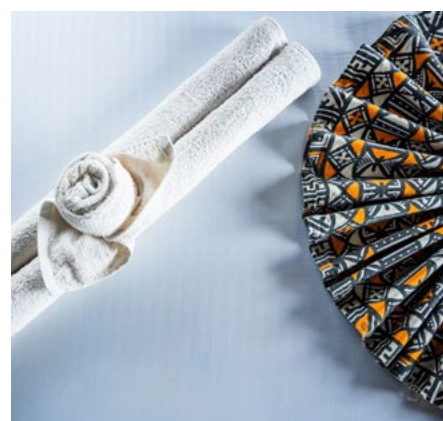


Basic, but effective, the Safari Tents are the perfect low-cost opportunity to experience the Serengeti.

Additionally, night game drives, as well as early morning or late afternoon walking safaris in the Ikona WMA are available and subject to additional entrance fees, along with charges for an accompanying armed TAWA ranger, driver, and vehicle. 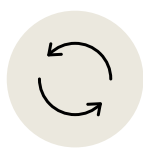
SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

With vast open plains and an abundance of wildlife as far as the eye can see, the Serengeti is a safari maker's dreamland. Because the park is so vast, it is advisable to spend several days exploring. Serengeti National Park stretches over 14,763 square kilometres and is easily the largest and perhaps the most popular of the Northern Circuit's National Parks. Serengeti is host to the Great Wildebeest Migration, when some six million hooves walk across the open plains, as more than 200,000 zebras and 300,000 Thomson's gazelles accompany the wildebeest on their journey to fresh grass. Serengeti's Seronera area is located in the south-central region of the park and is known for a large number of big cats; the lion, leopard, and cheetah are often spotted here. Elephants, giraffes, hippos, crocodiles, buffalo, and impala are also well-known inhabitants. The area is very popular because it is one of the most likely places to see a hunt. The landscape is dotted with "kopjes", rocky granite, or gneiss protrusions, more than 550 million years old and highly loved by some cats as lookouts during the hunt.

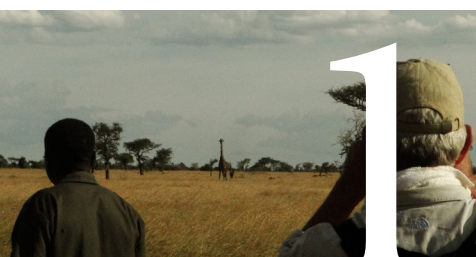

Activities

BUSHWALK + SUNDOWNER IN IKONA GAME CONTROLLED AREA

This migration corridor, through which the Grumeti River flows, is a buffer zone/ wildlife management area within a short driving distance of Africa Safari Serengeti Ikoma. A guide and an armed ranger will accompany you on this 2-kilometre walk. It is the perfect opportunity to look for the little things, identify and track footprints, examine the droppings of different animals, find insects, observe abundant birdlife, talk about plants and consider the ecosystem. The bushwalk ends on top of a hill for sundowners while you enjoy the sunset over the endless plains.



NIGHT GAME DRIVE

Take an afternoon snooze because, once darkness falls, you can embark on a thrilling adventure. Travelling in a safari vehicle fitted with a spotlight soon reveals the first glints of an animal's eyes. The night unmask a different world, showcasing the unique behaviour of nocturnal animals, mysterious shadows and unknown sounds. Typical animals of the night include bushbabies, civets, genet cats, porcupines and occasionally the rare armadillo, among others.



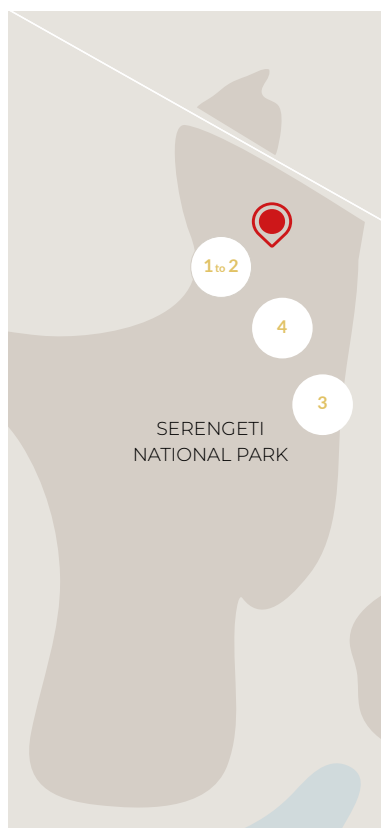
SERENGETI HOT AIR BALLOON FLIGHT

This popular excursion is a once-in-a-lifetime experience! You will be picked up at Africa Safari Serengeti Ikoma (early!) and taken to the launch site for a sunrise take-off. After a beautiful flight of approximately 1 hour, you will be toasted with champagne upon landing and served a 'full English' breakfast under a tree before being taken back to your safari guide at a pre-arranged location. This is only possible with a game drive as park fees will apply.

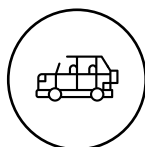
Airstrip / Airport

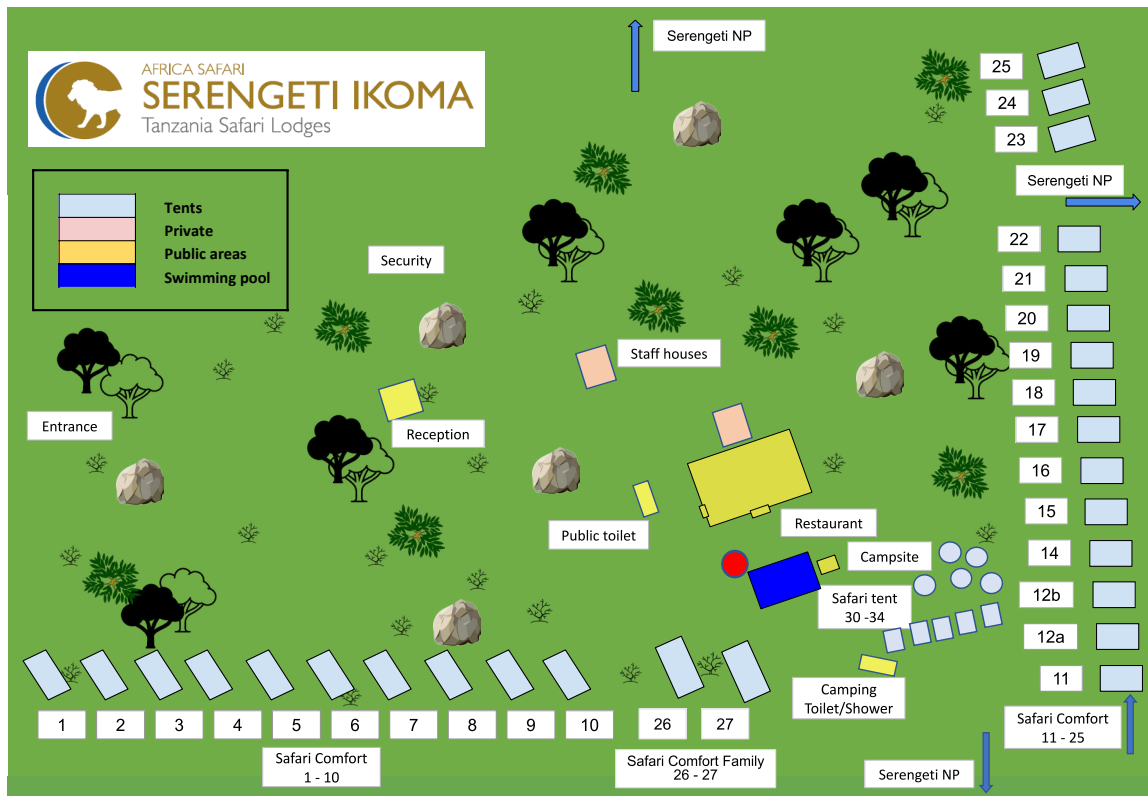

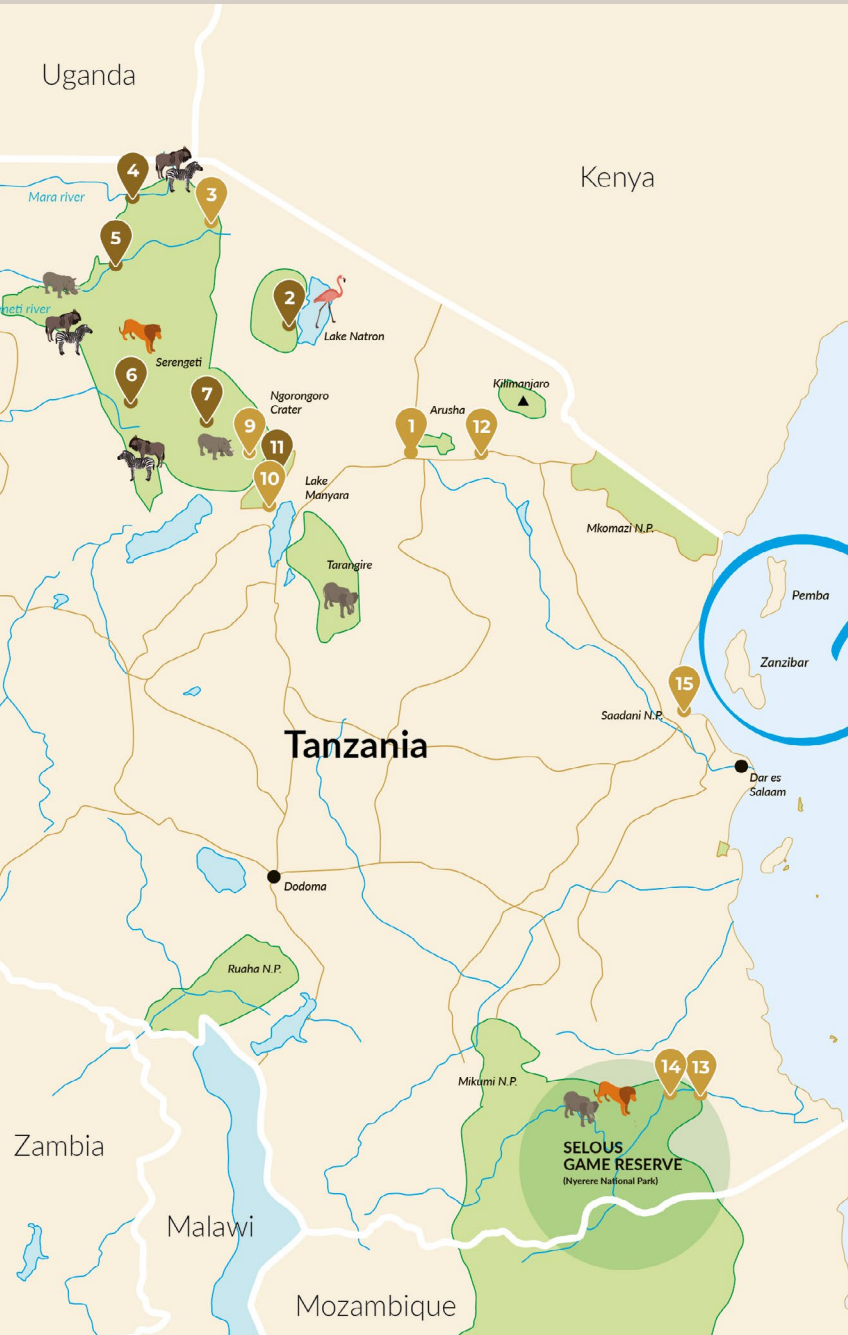
